Objective:-

- To make familiar the new students to the campus of Padm. Dr. V. B. Kolte College of Engineering, Malkapur.
- To provide academic counseling.
- To make aware the students of about professional ethics and etiquettes.
- To ease the trauma of transfer to a new place.
- To communicate with the ward's parents.
- To provide emotional support to students on individual basis.
- To help students to overcome home sickness.
- To establish rapport between teachers, student & parents.
- To monitor attendance and behavioral aspects of every student.
- To identify weak areas and working out remedies helping students thereby taking their complete care.

Highlights of the Scheme:

- One teacher is nominated as 'Teacher Guardian or mentor' for fifteen to twenty students.
- Teacher Guardian or mentor takes the follow up regarding attendance of students under his supervision.
- Teacher guardian monitors academic performance of students.
- Teacher guardian informs academic performance and attendance to parents
- Poor performance of students is improved by way of counseling. If required teacher guardian calls the parents on phone on the basis of monitoring.
- Teacher guardian does counseling about studies.

Procedure of the Mentoring System

- An effective Student mentoring system (SMS) has already been implemented in our college.
- All students of the college are covered under this system from the first day of college.
- A Mentoring register is distributed to all the staffs of the college. Each staff is allocated 15-20 students under the mentoring system.
- Faculties meet the students periodically and their academic progress and all his activities are discussed and noted in the register
- Any discrepancies in the student behavior like attendance, etc. are questioned and counseled with care.
- Staff submits the register to the HOD.
